### **Beth Hardy, vice president of strategy and stakeholder relations for the International CCS Knowledge Centre**

During the 34th annual [MOST Tripartite Alliance](#) conference several speakers including Beth Hardy provided insight and data around the Boilermaker's interest in advocating for carbon capture, use and storage as the only solution to mitigate climate change while allowing a reliable and realistic mix of renewables and clean fossil fuels. Hardy commented that the Centre has made sure Boilermakers are at the table in many of their carbon capture technology outreach meetings and presentations, including at the White House and during Climate Week in New York City. Another speaker, Bruce Folkedahl, senior research engineer for the Energy & Environmental Research Center at the

University of North Dakota, walked through data showing the potential economic impact of CCUS projects.
